



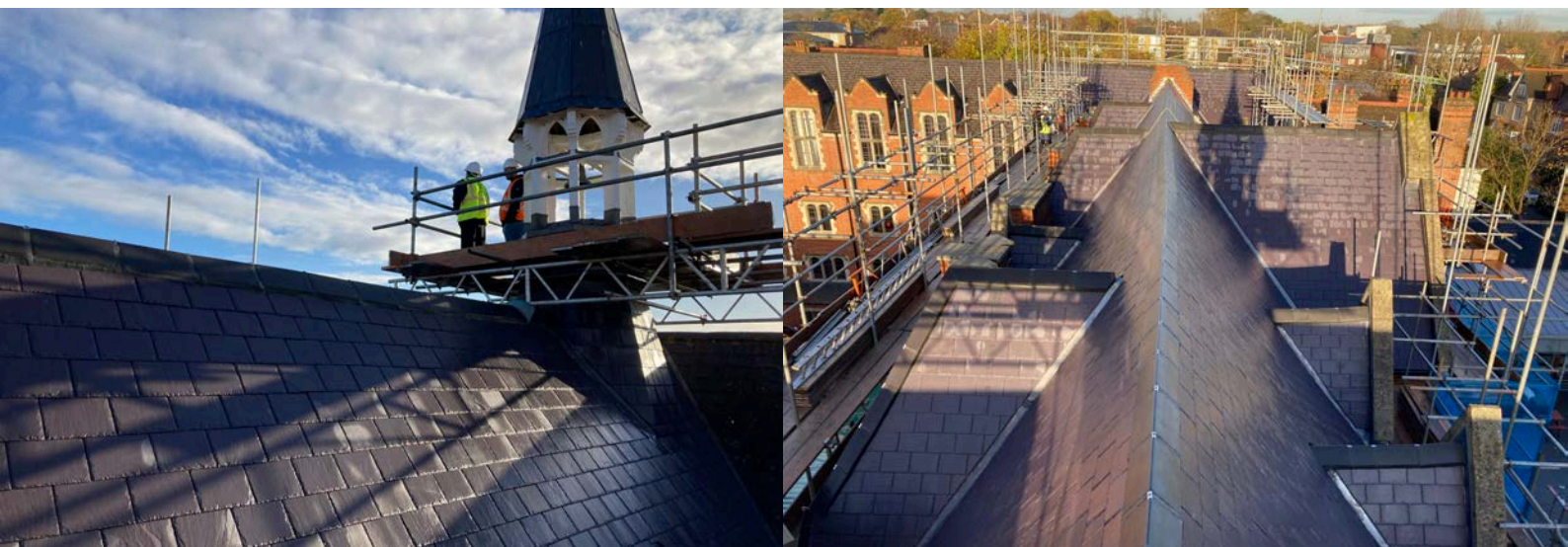
WIMBLEDON COLLEGE

The scope of this project was extensive, involving the replacement of rainwater goods, carpentry, faience, soffits, roof, and rooflights.
