



CRITERION THEATRE

As part of ongoing external maintenance to the Criterion Complex, Triton led as Principal Contractor for the repair and redecoration of the Criterion Theatre.

The finished appearance of the building had been previously marred by unsightly stains, caused by run-off from the inadequate drip detail to the leading edges of the cornices, string courses and horizontal projections, bird droppings, and graffiti.

The building was cleaned with water and detergent, and all repairs to the stonework were carried out with restoration mortar and a resin injection system. A Keim Granital system, with a 15 year guarantee, was applied to previously painted surfaces and a mastic drip was applied to the leading edge of all horizontal projections.

Situated in one of London's busiest tourist sites, particular attention was given to public safety and to the minimal disturbance of the occupants. Temporary plywood hoardings and barrier systems were provided and the scaffold itself was beamed over the ground floor shops, so that the obstructive standards could be kept to a minimum.
