## ST MARY'S CHURCHYARD, BEDDINGTON PARK, SUTTON



Triton was appointed to undertake the refurbishment and repairs to the Boundary wall of St Mary's Churchyard in Beddington Park, Sutton. This Church is of a historical standpoint and was first mentioned in the Domesday Book in 1086.

The wall which was worked on formed the western boundary of the site and extends from Church Walk through to the recent development at the Northern end of the site.

At high level, the works comprise reposed repair and remedial works to the entire section facing St Mary's Mansions to include up to and including the replacement of



wall at the Northern end where large voids exist necessitating a total rebuild; the use of salvaged and replacement bricks from architectural salvage; the use of mortar mixes to match existing following chemical analysis; awareness of possible retention of flora and fauna as directed by an ecology consultant, the temporary removal of headstones recording their exact location allowing the wall to be repaired followed by

rebedding of headstones; loose bricks to be cut out and replaced; removal of embedded glass fixed within top of angled coping ; repainting of brickwork in isolated sections; general cleaning of brick and mortar surfaces & repair/remove/ renew render on St Mary's Mansion side.
